1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.87 dated 01.10.2024 registered under Sections 74, 79 & 351(2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Police Station Sadar, Rupnagar.
