1. The present contempt proceedings have been sought to be initiated against the respondents for the alleged willful non-compliance of order dated 04.07.2024 passed by the Competent Authority.

Without going into the merits of the controversy, Mr. Pradeep Virk, Advocate appearing on behalf of respondents No.1 & 2, on specific instructions, submits that an application seeking modification of the order dated 04.07.2024, filed at the instance of respondents No.1 & 2 is pending consideration before the authority below for 05.05.2025 and respondents No.1 & 2 undertake before this Court to furnish security/surety/bank
