Petitioner, a complainant, at whose behest criminal proceedings vide FIR No.93 dated 24.08.2024, under Sections 309(2), 115(2), 351(2) 324(6) and 3(5) of BNS, was registered against private respondents No.5 to 7, at Police Station Bahawala, District Fazilka, has filed the present petition, praying for issuance of direction to the official respondents No.1 to 4 to decide the representation dated 04.07.2025 (Annexure P2), moved by the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel submits that despite the fact that the above said FIR was lodged about a year ago, accused are roaming free, no investigations have been conducted and neither any of the accused has been arrested. Learned counsel further submits that private respondents No.5 to 7 are habitual offenders and as many as five criminal cases are registered against respondent No.5.

5. After considering the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and the averments made in the petition, without commenting on

the merits thereof, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3 Superintendent of Police, Fazilka to consider and dispose of the representation dated 04.07.2025 (Annexure P-2), within a period of 04 weeks, in accordance with law in an expeditious manner. The decision so taken be intimated to the petitioner as well.
