1. On 09.11.2023, the following submissions were made by learned counsel for the petitioner:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter already stands amicably settled between the parties way back in the year 2014. However, since the petitioner had been declared a proclaimed person, he was unable to travel from Portugal to India as he had a genuine apprehension that he could be arrested on his arrival in India. Learned counsel contends that the petitioner is willing to travel to India and surrender before the Trial Court, however, he may be granted interim protection. Learned counsel undertakes to place on record a copy of the air tickets of the petitioner qua his intended visit to India.”

2. Thereafter, the case had been repeatedly adjourned, however, a perusal of all the orders thereafter reveal that there has been no representation on behalf of the petitioner including a request made on 15.01.2024 for some more time to comply with the order dated 09.11.2023. Today yet again, the case has been called twice, however, none has entered appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

3. In the circumstances, the instant petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
