1. Petitioners, who claim themselves to be the office bearers of Market Association of Section 67, Mohali, have filed the present petition, vide which they have prayed to direct the official respondents to clear the encroachments made by illegal car bazaar dealers on the government land opposite to the parking lot of Sector 67, Booth Market, Mohali.

2. Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the Booth Market of Section 67, Mohali was sold through auction proceedings of Greater Mohali Area Development Authority (GMADA) in 2013-14. However, some persons started illegally parking their cars in the vacant place, just opposite to the parking lot, causing huge inconvenience to the shop owners and their customers. Various representations were also given to the police officials to take appropriate action, but the needful has not been done till today.



After arguing for sometime, learned counsel restricts his prayer to direct the official respondents to decide his representation dated 02.07.2025 (Annexure P-6), in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

- 3. Notice of motion to official respondents only.
- 4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Kamalpreet Bawa, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State.
- 5. After considering the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners and the averments made in the petition, without commenting on the merits thereof, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3 - Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali to consider and dispose of the representation dated 02.07.2025 (Annexure P-6), in accordance with law in an expeditious manner. The decision so taken be intimated to the petitioners as well.
