1. The present contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 27.05.2022 passed by this Court in CR-8227-2018.

2. The relevant portion of order dated 27.05.2022 passed by this Court in CR-8227-2018 is reproduced as under:-

“ If there was any interim order passed in the suit which was continuing till the impugned order was passed, the same will continue to operate. However, if it did not exist upto the date of passing of impugned order, this Court does not find it appropriate to extend the interim order.”

2. Learned counsel for the parties submits that the compromise has been effected between the parties, therefore the present contempt petition be dismissed as not pressed.

3. In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed as not pressed.
