The petitioners are seeking a direction to the respondents to rehabilitate the petitioners before evicting them from the site.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the exercise for removal of the encroachments is being carried out by them in pursuance to the directions dated 16.01.2025 issued by this Court in CWP-28729-2013. He, upon instructions from Mr. Lalit Hans, Junior Engineer, EO-1, submits that only 84 petitioners out of 207 petitioners have been found to be eligible for allotment of a flat under the Aashiana Scheme. He has furnished a list of eligible families/applicants in this regard, which is taken on record. He upon instructions further submits that the demolition drive would not be carried out for another 15 days in view of the inclement weather.



3. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this petition with liberty to seek recourse to the alternative remedy in accordance with law.

4. The petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
