At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner gives an undertaking that the petitioner shall hand over the vacant possession of demised premises to the respondent within a period of 30 days from today onwards.

The offer so made is acceptable to the learned counsel for the respondents and also he submits that in view of the statement made aforesaid, he shall also not press for the application bearing CM-2686-CII-2024 for grant of mesne profit.

In view of the submissions aforesaid, the present petition is hereby dismissed as withdrawn, on the basis of the undertaking given by learned counsel for the petitioner and petitioner is directed to hand over the vacant possession of the demised premises to the respondents within a period of 30 days from today onwards. The petitioner shall remain bound by this

statement, failing which, the respondent shall have an option to seek appropriate remedy under the law.

All pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
