The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case registered against him vide FIR No.25 dated 10.07.2025 under Sections 406, 409, 418, 420, 467, 468, 471, 474, 477-A, 120-B, 193, 196, 199, 200 IPC and Sections 13(2), 13(1)(c), 13(1)(d) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 at Police Station Anti Corruption Bureau, District Hisar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 09.09.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 09.09.2025 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.

Petition stands disposed of.
