1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under article 226/227 of the Constitution of India with a prayer that this Hon'ble Court may issue a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the impugned final revised result dated 30.11.2023 (Annexure P-9) declared by the respondent No.2 for the post of Radiographer/Ultrasound Technician of Health Department Haryana which were advertised in Advt. No.15/2019 dated 07.09.2019 (Annexure P-1), as earlier in the final result dated 07.03.2022 (Annexure P-6) the petitioner was finally selected for the post in question because the petitioner secured 38 marks in BCA category which are higher marks to the Cutoff marks i.e. 33 marks. But in the revised final result dated 30.11.2023 (Annexure P-9) without passing any order giving any reason, surprisingly the roll of the petitioner was not considered despite being eligible and having higher marks to the last selected candidates with a further prayer to direct the respondent Commission to revise the result or include the roll no. of the petitioner for the post of Radiographer/Ultrasound Technicians after the petitioner eligible because the petitioner secured more marks than the last selected candidate in BCA category i.e. Diploma and also having higher qualification i.e. Degree of Bachelor in Science and Radiology



and imaging Technology before the advt. from the recognized university.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied, in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 10.08.2025 (Annexure P-15) within a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Rahul Dev Singh, Addl. A.G., Haryana, having served with an advance copy of the petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and assures the Court that the legal notice dated 10.08.2025 (Annexure P-15) shall be decided by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.

5. In view of the above, and without adverting to the merits of the case, the respondent No.2- Secretary, Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Bays No.67-70, Sector 2, Panchkula, is directed to consider and decide the legal notice dated 10.08.2025 (Annexure P-15), by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. A copy of order so passed be supplied to the petitioner within one week thereafter.

7. Petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
