SHALINI SINGH NAGPAL J. (Oral)

1. Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case arising out of FIR No. 76 dated 06.08.2025, registered under Sections 316(2), 85 Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 Police Station Women Cell, Ludhiana. This is his first petition for anticipatory bail.

2. Vide order dated 09.09.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner was granted interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

3. Learned State counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of Rajesh Kumar, PPS, ACP, Licensing and Security, Additional Charge CAW & C-Cell, Ludhiana, and perusal of para No. 5 of said report shows that petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

4. Mr. Prabhjot Singh Mann, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No. 2-complainant and filed his power of attorney.



He opposes the prayer of anticipatory bail alleging respondent No. 2 was thrown out of the matrimonial home during pregnancy and it was a case of extreme cruelty.

5. Considering all relevant facts and circumstances of the case, but without commenting on merits, the petition is allowed and order dated 09.09.2025, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023.
