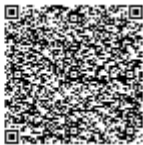

1. Prayer in this petition, filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of directions in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing the respondents to produce her minor son named Ajansh aged two years before this Court and hand over his custody to the petitioner.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, points out that the contesting parties to the *lis* have already resolved the dispute and have entered into a compromise. In this view of the matter, he does not press the prayer made in the present petition and therefore submits that the petition be disposed of.
