1. The contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 03.09.2025 passed in LPA-2083-2025, which is reproduced as under:-

“CM-6303-LPA-2025

This application under Section 151 CPC has been filed on behalf of the applicant-appellant for preponement of the date of hearing in the main appeal being LPA-2083-2025.

No ground for preponement of the date of hearing in the main case is made out.

Dismissed.

CM-6304-LPA-2025

Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.

CM-6305-LPA-2025

This application under Section 151 CPC has been filed on behalf of the applicant-appellant for issuing direction to the respondents to provisionally allow the



appellant to appear in the Subject Knowledge Test to be held on 14.09.2025.

Learned counsel for the applicant-appellant submits that the similar situated candidates in LPA-2375-2025 has already been granted interim relief to provisionally participate in the Subject Knowledge Test.

Notice in the application.

Mr. Saurabh Mohunta, DAG, Haryana enters appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Ms. Harpriya Khaneka, Advocate, enters appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-HPSC.

Adjourned to 13.10.2025 along with the main case.

To be heard along with LPA-2375-2025.

Interim order in the same terms as in LPA-2375-2025.”

2. The order dated 13.08.2025 passed in LPA-2375-2025 is reproduced as under:-

*“Learned Single Bench has denied interim relief to the appellant relying on the earlier judgment of the Writ Court in CWP-27144-2023 titled as **Suman Mor** Vs. **State of Haryana and Others**, decided on 13.12.2023.*

*Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the judgement in **Suman Mor** (Supra) was assailed in LPA-2096-2023, wherein an interim protection was granted on 19.12.2023. The appellant therein was provisionally allowed to participate in the subject knowledge test. However, as the appellant had not qualified such exam, as such the LPA was dismissed.*

It is submitted that the appellant had correctly filled her Roll Number, but when it came to circling the digits, one of the circles was inadvertently left blank.

Matter requires consideration.

Notice of motion.



Mr. Pankaj Middha, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and seeks time to file reply.

Adjourned to 13.10.2025.

In the meantime, the appellant is provisionally allowed to participate in the subject knowledge test scheduled to be held on 17.08.2025.”

- 3. Learned counsel for respondent contends that admit card has been issued to the petitioner and he is allowed to participate in Subject Knowledge Test provisionally.
- 4. Learned counsel for the petitioner is satisfied with the same and contends that order dated 03.09.2025 passed in LPA-2083-2025 has been complied with.
- 5. In view of the same, the contempt is purged and rule is discharged.
