1. The petitioners have filed the present writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to issue a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the order dated 27.05.2025 (Annexure P-5) passed by respondent No.2, whereby, the process of station allotment qua the petitioners has been followed in arbitrary and non-transparent manner.
2. Learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of petitioners submits that vide order dated 27.05.2025 (Annexure P-5) passed by respondent No.2, petitioners have been promoted to the post of Lecturer in Physical Education. Thereafter, prior and after the promotion of the petitioners, the options were given to the Lecturers, who are admittedly juniors to the petitioners and the places of postings offered to them were significantly closer to their respective places of residence. However, no opportunity was given to the petitioners to submit their preferences for the places of postings.

3. On advance notice, Mr. Satnampreet Singh Chauhan,DAG, Punjab has appeared on behalf of official respondents and on instructions from Dr. Amandeep Kaur, Assistant Director O/o Directorate of School Education (Secondary) Punjab submits that the process of station allotment shall be carried out by the respondents in a more transparent and fair manner and all the petitioners shall also be given the option to apply for the places of postings, which are lying vacant, at this moment.
4. In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel, learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of petitioners does not want to press the present petition.
5. Dismissed as not pressed, at this stage.
6. It is expected that the respondents shall proceed with the matter, in accordance with law.
