By way of present petition filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, petitioners seek quashing of FIR (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise/affidavit dated 10.10.2024 (Annexure P-2) executed between the parties. Details of the FIR are as follows:

2. With the intervention of respectables and elderly people of the society, the parties have arrived at a settlement vide



compromise/affidavit dated 10.10.2024 (Annexure P-2), which is duly signed by them. The matter was referred to the Court below for recording of statements of the parties and to report with respect to genuineness of the compromise arrived at between the parties. Learned Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ferozepur, vide report dated 01.04.2025, has apprised this Court that the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine and without any pressure. In compliance to the order dated 13.02.2025, an amount of Rs.20,000/- has been deposited with the Poor Patients Welfare Fund, PGIMER and Rs.20,000/- has been deposited with Society for the Care of Blind, Sector 26, Chandigarh and receipt thereof is annexed with the report. .

3. Respondent No. 2 to 5 are represented by their counsel and does not oppose the compromise.

4. In view of the report of the Learned Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ferozepur and in view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in “Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another”, 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and “Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another”, (2014) 6 SCC 466, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping with the criminal proceedings pending, since the complainants have compromised the dispute with the petitioners/accused persons.

5. In these circumstances, the present petition is allowed. FIR No.133 dated 30.06.2019, 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 307

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IPC added vide rata No.2 dated 07.07.2019 and Section 307 IPC has been deleted and Section 326 IPC added later on, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Ferozepur (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise qua the present petitioners.
