1. Through the instant writ petitions, as cast under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a Mandamus upon the respondents to decide the 2nd Appeals, dated 05.11.2024, preferred by the petitioner, in a time bound manner.

2. On the last of hearing, i.e. 11.09.2025, this Court had passed the hereinafter extracted order:-

“1. At this stage, without issuing notice, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the learned State Counsel to have instructions from the respondent No.1 and inform this



Court, on the next date of hearing, as to how much time is required to decide the appeals filed by the petitioner.

2. List on 15.09.2025.”

3. In response, learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Harpreet Singh Sandhu, State Information Commissioner, fairly submits that the appeals filed by the petitioner, will be considered and decided within a period of four weeks from the date of passing of the order. Therefore, he further submits that the petitions at hand may be disposed of.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner is in agreement with the course suggested by learned State counsel, and submits that let these petitions be disposed of, in terms of the statement made by learned State counsel.

5. In view of the above statements made by learned counsel for the parties, the instant writ petitions are accordingly **disposed of**.

6. However, in case, the appeals (supra) are not decided within the stipulated period, he is at liberty to move an apt application/motion for revival of the instant petitions.
