1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.143 dated 21.09.2024 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 120-B of IPC and Section 13 of Punjab Prevention of Human Smuggling Act, 2012, at Police Station Civil Lines Bathinda, District Bathinda.
2. Vide order dated 02.12.2024, the case was referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court to explore the possibility of the compromise between the parties. Today learned Mediator has reported that the parties have signed the settlement/agreement dated 12.12.2024.
3. Learned counsel for the parties submit that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties and the parties shall remain bound by the terms of the compromise/agreement.

4. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 28.10.2024 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S/438(2) of Cr.P.C.
