At this stage, respondent No.2 is directed to decide the representation dated 26.05.2025 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, by passing a speaking and well reasoned order. It is expected that respondent No.2 shall pass a speaking and well-reasoned order by taking into consideration the relevant rules, instructions and the settled law. In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled to any consequential relief, the same shall be released to him forthwith along with a reasonable rate of interest.

7. The present petition is disposed of, accordingly.
