1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to issue a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to forthwith release the correctly calculated balance amount of interest on the delayed payment of retiral dues of late Amarjit Singh (retired Mathematics Master), in strict compliance with the binding orders dated 06.08.2024 passed in CWP No.2163 of 2018 (Annexure P-1) and order dated 20.03.2025 passed in COCP No.315 of 2025 (Annexure P-2). A further prayer has been made to issue a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 07.04.2025 (Annexure P-3) by passing a reasoned and speaking order, after due consideration of the revised and correct calculation sheet submitted by the petitioner (Annexure P-4) within a time bound manner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 07.04.2025 (Annexure P-3) to the respondent No.2 and at this stage, she shall be satisfied in case, appropriate

directions are issued to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 07.04.2025 (Annexure P-3) in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Surya Kumar, AAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and has no serious objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record carefully.

6. At this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 07.04.2025 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner, within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order by passing a speaking and well reasoned order. In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled to any consequential relief, the same shall also be released to him forthwith alongwith a reasonable rate of interest.
