1. Prayer in this petition under Section 482 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.28 dated 24.01.2025 registered under Sections 109, 115(2), 117(2), 126(2), 190, 191(3), 110, 115, 126 of BNS and Section 25 (1-B)(a) of Arms Act, at Police Station Pataudi, District Gurugram.

2. Status report by way of an affidavit of Shri Sukhbir Singh, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Pataudi, Gurugram has been filed on behalf of respondent No.1 and the same is taken on record.

3. On 12.09.2025, following order was passed:-

“Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of BNSS for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.28 dated 24.01.2025 under Sections 109, 115(2), 117(2), 126(2), 190, 191(3), 110, 115, 126 of BNS and Section 25(1-B) (a) of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Pataudi, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the petitioner has not been named in the FIR and later on his name surfaced in the present case on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused. He urged that no specific injury has been attributed to the petitioner. The compromise has already been effected between the parties and



the quashing proceedings are pending in the present FIR on the basis of compromise. He has further submitted that in the trial which is pending against the co- accused the complainant has not supported the prosecution version and has turned hostile. Co-accused, namely, Bharat, Kunal @ Gunga, Badal, Pankaj, Gaurav @ Munshi, Jatin, Sachin Sharma have already been granted concession of bail. He has further submitted that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required for any purpose and he is ready and willing to join the investigation.

Notice of motion.

Mr. R.K. Singla, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and seeks time to file status report.

List on 01.12.2025.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/ Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482(2) BNSS.”

4. Today, learned State counsel has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 12.09.2025 and is no longer required for further investigation.

5. In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 12.09.0225, whereby the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, he shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.

6. Disposed of.

7. Pending misc application (s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
