This is an application under Section 5 of the Limitation Act for condonation of delay of 180 days in filing the appeal.

Keeping in view the facts mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and the delay of 180 days in filing the appeal is condoned.

1. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the appellants submits that the fact that the respondent had already sold the vehicle bearing registration No.HR74-A-7175 involved in offence committed under Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015, to one Wasim Akram on 04.03.2016 i.e. prior to the date of incident by General Power of Attorney and duly sworn affidavit and the said Wasim Akram had already been



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acquitted thereafter, the said fact could not be brought to the notice of the learned Single Judge before passing of the impugned order dated 10.02.2025 in CWP-24399-2022 hence, the present appeal may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to file a review before the learned Single Judge.

2. Ordered accordingly.
3. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
