This bunch of 18 petitions is essentially filed with the grievance that the respondents are not opening the portal for renewal of the registration of their stone crushing units in terms of Clause 13 of the Punjab Crusher Policy, 2023.

On 28.10.2024, the following order was passed:-

“The specific case of the petitioners is that they are not being allowed renewal of the registration of their stone crushing unit(s) through the online registration facility/portal system as per Clause 13 of the Punjab Crusher Policy, 2023. It is submitted that merely on account of the demands raised of various amounts (Annexure P-3), the petitioner(s) are not being allowed renewal and the registration is either expiring today or had expired yesterday.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Shekhar Verma, Addl. A.G, Punjab, accepts notice and is not able to demonstrate any clause which prohibits the petitioner(s) from applying for the renewal merely on account of the pendency of the proceedings in the absence of any specific order.

In our considered opinion, the action of the respondents in not permitting the petitioner(s) to apply for renewal of registration is not justified. Accordingly, we direct that the petitioner(s) be permitted to apply on deposit of necessary fees and the respondents-State shall open the necessary portal.

To come up on 10.12.2024.

Photocopy of this order be placed on the files of the connected cases.”

The State has filed its reply stating that, in compliance of the directions of the Court, the online portal for registration was opened. It is also the case of the respondents that the grievance of the petitioners already stands redressed. Para No.7 of the reply is reproduced hereinbelow:-

“That the relief sought by the petitioner is to open the online registration facility/portal system so that it can apply for the renewal of the registration of the petitioner's stone crushing unit, stands redressed. As such, the answering respondent seeks the indulgence of this Hon'ble court to dismiss the instant writ petition having been rendered infructuous.”

There is no challenge to the assertion made by the State in its reply.

In such view of the matter, we dispose of the petitions as having been rendered infructuous and consign the records of these petitions with the observations that no further grievance survives in respect of the cause brought before this Court in the present bunch of petitions.
