1. This is the first petition filed under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS) for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.0156 dated 24.07.2023 under Sections 22(c) of NDPS Act registered at Police Station Lambi, Shri Muktsar Sahib.

2. Learned State counsel, at the very outset, on instructions from ASI Sukhraj, submits that the trial of the case is likely to conclude as only three witnesses are remaining to be examined and next date of hearing is 21.05.2025. Further, all the prosecution witnesses would be produced on the next date of hearing.

3. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition and confines his prayer to the extent that a direction may be issued to conclude the trial in a time bound manner.

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4. In view of the fact that only three witnesses are remaining to be examined and the next date of hearing before the learned trial Court is fixed for 21.05.2025, the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously, preferably within a period of 04 months.
