1. Today, lawyers are abstaining from work.
2. Prayer in this petition filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 is for quashing of G.D. No.28 dated 16.03.2023, under Sections 323, 324, 379, 506, 148 and 149 of IPC, 1860 (Section 379 stands deleted vide G.D. No.22 dated 26.01.2024), Police Station Tarsikka, District Amritsar (Rural) in case FIR No.16 dated 10.03.2023, under Sections 323, 324, 427, 341, 506, 148 and 149 of IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Tarsikka, District Amritsar (Rural) (Annexure P-2) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.
3. This Court vide order dated 16.09.2025 had directed the parties to appear before the Trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send his/her report qua the genuineness of the compromise.
4. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties had appeared before learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Baba Bakala Sahib, Amritsar and got



their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Magistrate has submitted report dated 31.10.2025 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

5. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served by continuing with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant F.I.R. following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052 titled as '*Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another*' and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in (2012) 10 SCC 303 titled as '*Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others*'. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the G.D. No.28 dated 16.03.2023, under Sections 323, 324, 379, 506, 148 and 149 of IPC, 1860 (Section 379 stands deleted vide G.D. No.22 dated 26.01.2024), Police Station Tarsikka, District Amritsar (Rural) in case FIR No.16 dated 10.03.2023, under Sections 323, 324, 427, 341, 506, 148 and 149 of IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Tarsikka, District Amritsar (Rural) (Annexure P-2) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.

6. Pending misc application (s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
