1. Present petition has been filed by the petitioner, seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.254, dated 23.08.2025, under Section(s) 115, 190, 191(3), 324(4), 333, 351(2) of BNS and during investigation, the police were deleted section 115 of BNS and sections 115(2), 117(2), 303(2), 61(2) of BNS were added, registered at Police Station Ballabgarh, District Faridabad.

2. After going through the record on 18.09.2025, following order was passed by this Court:-

*“1. On a call given by the High Court Bar Association, lawyers are observing strike today and not appearing in the Court(s).*

*2. As per the allegations, Bhagat Singh, Balwant Singh son of Shreepal, Bhola, Pintu, Bedu, Bijju, Sukhdev and 3-4 other persons came to the liquor vend and started abusing Abhishekh and salesman Sachin Pal. They were armed with lathi, danda and hammer. In order to save themselves, Abhishekh and Sachin Pal locked themselves in the*

*liquor vend. When they did not open the bolt, the assailants started breaking the security net of the liquor vend with bricks, stones and hammer. By forcibly intruding in the liquor vend, they all gave beatings to Abhishekh and threatened Sachin Pal to not to intervene in the matter.*

*3. SI Vinod Kumar, who is present in the Court, informs that injured Abhishekh has suffered total 8 injuries and 5 of them are grievous in nature.*

*4. List again on 30.09.2025.”*

3. To counter the allegations of causing eight injuries, including five grievous in nature, to the injured Abhishekh, counsel for the petitioner relies upon the Medical Legal Report (MLR) dated 21.08.2025 of the petitioner, and refers to the injuries mentioned therein, which are reproduced below, for reference:-

4. Counsel for the petitioner also refers to the photographs of the injuries suffered by the petitioner, which are appended with the present petition as Annexure P-2.

5. This Court has heard the submissions advanced by counsel for the parties and carefully examined the record before it.

6. It is noticed that the incident occurred at a liquor shop where the injured, Abhishekh, was already present, employed, and working inside the premises. Under ordinary circumstances, it cannot be expected that the injured would create any unwarranted situation to cause injuries to the petitioner. Furthermore, it is an admitted position that petitioner, along with other co-accused, had gone to the liquor shop where injured – Abhishekh was working.

Considering the total number of injuries sustained by the injured, five of which are grievous in nature, coupled with the allegation that petitioner and his co-accused snatched Rs.13,500/- along with the DVR and CCTV camera installed in the shop, this Court is not inclined to exercise its inherent discretionary power to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, present petition for anticipatory bail is **dismissed**.
