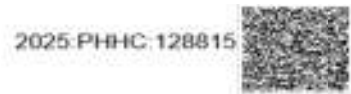
YASHVIR SINGH RATHOR, J. (Oral)

1. Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 for protecting the lives and liberty of the petitioners, who apprehend threat to their life at the hands of private respondents No.4 & 5 and not to interfere in their peaceful lives and further to take action on the representation dated 12.09.2025 (Annexure P-3).

2. Notice of motion.

3. On the asking of Court, Mr. G.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and assures that respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur would look into the representation/complaint dated 12.09.2025 (Annexure P-3).

4. In view of the above, respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur is directed to look into the



representation and decide the same on the basis of threat perception felt by the petitioners and if the threat perception is found to be true then the protection as admissible in law shall be provided. In case, the concerned SSP is of the view that no protection is required, then a speaking order shall be passed and communicated to the petitioners.

- 6. Pending misc. application (s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
