Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioners have joined the investigation on 25.04.2025 but they are not cooperating with the Investigation Agency as they have not demarcated the place of occurrence

and have not got recovered the bike which was used at the time of occurrence. Non demarcation of place on occurrence and non-recovery of bike cannot be considered to be a ground of declining of concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners.

Given the nature of the allegations as levelled against the petitioners and the fact that the injuries sustained by the complainant have been opined to be simple in nature except one injury and in the peculiar facts and circumstance and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, both the petitions are allowed and the order dated 05.11.2024 passed in CRM-M-54747-2024 and order dated 29.11.2024 passed in CRM-M-59878-2024, thereby, directing the petitioners to be released on interim bail are made absolute, subject to compliance of terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNS.
