1. This writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant Compassionate Financial Assistance, Family pension and other benefits which are admissible to the legal heirs of deceased government employee i.e. Mr. Bansi Lal Malik R/o Piplikhera, Tehsil Ganaur, District Sonapat, employed as DPE as per Haryana Civil Service (Compassionate Financial Assistance or Appointment) Rules, 2019 (Annexure P-1) and grant of other reliefs as made out in the present case to the petitioners as per law, rules, regulations, policies as per applicable.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that they will be satisfied, in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 08.11.2024 (Annexure P-2) within a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Rahul Dev Singh, Addl. A.G., Haryana, having served with

an advance copy of the petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and assures the Court that the representation dated 08.11.2024 (Annexure P-2) shall be decided by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.

5. In view of the above, and without adverting to the merits of the case, the respondent No.2- Director, Elementary Education Haryana, Shiksha Sadan, Sectore-5 Panchkula is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 08.11.2024 (Annexure P-2), after providing opportunity of hearing to the parties, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. A copy of order so passed be supplied to the petitioners within next week thereafter.

7. Petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
