The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *certiorari* quashing the transfer order dated 26.08.2025, Annexure P-2, whereby the petitioner has been ordered to be transferred from her present place of posting, i.e., GBN, Government Polytechnic, Nilokheri, Karnal to Government Polytechnic for Women, Faridabad.

2. Learned counsel contends that the petitioner is a widow having a minor child of about nine years of age. She was given compassionate appointment as Peon-cum-Attendant vide memo dated 20.12.2019, and has now been transferred to a far away place/Government Polytechnic for Women, Faridabad. The order is not in public interest, nor has it been statedly passed on account of any administrative exigency. It will be extremely difficult for her to make both ends meet at this far removed place.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in case the petitioner makes a representation for adjustment in a nearby polytechnic, the



Department will consider the same and pass an appropriate order within three weeks.

4. In view thereof, the petition stands disposed of permitting the petitioner to make a representation seeking adjustment in a nearby polytechnic to the second respondent/Director General, Technical Education, within ten days from today which will be sympathetically considered and decided by passing an appropriate order; till the office conveys it to the petitioner, the impugned transfer order, dated 26.08.2025, shall not be given effect to.
