1. The petitioner has filed the present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to issue a writ in the nature of *Mandamus* directing the respondents to promote the petitioner as Lecturer English from the date his junior has been promoted along with all consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 07.08.2025 (Annexure P-4) on the respondents and he shall be satisfied in case, appropriate directions are issued to the respondents to decide his aforesaid representation.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Charanpreet Singh, AAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of

respondents No.1 to 3 and has no serious objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record carefully.

6. At this stage, respondent No.2 is directed to decide the representation dated 07.08.2025 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, by passing a speaking and well reasoned order.

7. In case, the petitioner is found entitled to the relief claimed in the instant petition, the same shall be released to him along with a reasonable rate of interest forthwith.

8. The present petition is disposed off, accordingly
