Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking anticipatory bail in a complaint case No.COMI-227-2022 dated 08.08.2022 titled as “*Tejpal Singh Vs. Rajan Mehta*” under Sections 406/420 of IPC pending in the Court of Ld.
