The petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner on parity with similarly situated persons who have been allotted stations afresh vide orders dated 26.09.2024 and 30.04.2025, Annexures P-4 and P-8 respectively.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent no.2 is directed to decide her pending representation, dated 21.05.2025, Annexure P-9, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Amit Sahni, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 and 3/State. Mr. Sanjeev Kaushik, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent no.2/Parishad, and submits that the pending representation, dated 21.05.2025, will be decided by respondent no.2/State Project Director, Haryana

School Shiksha Pariyojna Parishad, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, within a period of three months.

5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
