N.S.SHEKHAWAT, J.

1. The petitioner has filed the second petition under Section 483 of the B.N.S.S., 2023 with a prayer to grant regular bail in case FIR No.168 dated 19.04.2024 registered under Sections 15(c)/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short, '**the NDPS Act**') at Police Station Dabwali Sadar, District Dabwali.
2. Vide order dated 03.04.2025, Gobind petitioner was granted the concession of interim bail by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court.
3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that after the grant of interim bail, the petitioner has not

misused the concession of bail in any manner and is regularly appearing before the trial Court.

4. On the other hand, learned State counsel has vehemently opposed the prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner on the ground that there are serious allegations against the petitioner and the petitioner is not entitled for the concession of regular bail. However, he submits that the petitioner has not misused the concession of bail in any manner.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

6. In the present case, the petitioner was ordered to be released on *interim* bail on 03rd April 2025 and admittedly, no misuse of bail has been reported.

7. In view of the above, without commenting any further on the merits, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate/CJM concerned. He shall continue to appear before the trial Court on the each and every date of hearing and shall not absent himself.
