1. In the present quashing petition filed on the basis of compromise, this Court had directed the parties on 29.11.2023 to appear and got recorded their statements before the Court below.

In pursuance to the said direction, victims, namely, Paramjit Saini and Sachin Singh appeared and got recorded their statements separately by stating that they have no objection if the present FIR is quashed qua the accused for all intents and purposes. However, complainant Vijay Saini has not appeared for suffering statement.

From accused side, only one of the accused, namely, Lakhbir Singh appeared and suffered his statement. No other accused, namely, Tejinder Singh and Manpreet Singh @ Mani appeared before the Court below to make statement.

Further, no-one has put in appearance today on behalf of the petitioners to clear the factual position.

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2. In view of the Division Bench judgement rendered by this Court in the case of **Rakesh Das vs. State of Haryana, CRM-M-48043-2023, decided on 12.11.2024** (2024(4) Law Herald 3141), prayer for quashing the proceedings partially, on the basis of compromise, cannot be entertained.

Therefore, the present petition is dismissed being not maintainable.

However, it may be open for all the accused to file a comprehensive petition together by impleading all the necessary parties, i.e. complainants and the victims.
