KULDEEP TIWARI. J.(Oral)

1. Through the instant writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for quashing of order dated 09.04.2025 (Annexure P-8 to P-11), on the ground that the same are totally non-speaking order and does not pass the test of legality.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners, submits that specific directions were passed by this Court while disposing of a bunch of petition in CWP-8912-2016 (Annexure P-2), to consider the claim of the present petitioners therein, while passing a speaking order, which has not been done by the respondents concerned. Therefore, it is a clear violation of the directions issued by this Court.

3. At this stage, on an advance notice issued, Mr. Kanwal Goyal, Advocate, has caused appearance on behalf of respondents, through a validly executed power of attorney in his favour. The same is taken on record.

4. He informs this Court that, in fact, a detailed order has been passed, however, the same has yet not been, communicated to the petitioners. He assures the Court that the detailed order shall be communicated to the petitioners in due course, preferably, within a period of seven days from today itself.

5. In view of the abovesaid statement suffered by learned counsel for the respondents, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that she may be allowed to withdraw the instant petition, with liberty to challenge the speaking order, so passed, by the respondents, and in case the petitioners, fetches any grievance from the same, they are at liberty to file an apt motion before this Court.

6. **Dismissed as withdrawn** with the aforesaid liberty.

7. It is expected that the respondents shall communicate the speaking order, so passed by them, within a period of seven working days, from the passing of this order.
