Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of necessary direction to respondent Nos. 2 to 4 to protect life and liberty of petitioner and his family members and for inquiry into the unlawful actions of certain individuals, including police officers.

(2) Learned State counsel while making reference to Para No. 15 of the status report dated 28.11.2024, submits that petitioner is facing 03 criminal cases and for reference relevant part of Para No. 15 (*supra*) reads as under:-

(3) In view of the factual position noticed herein above, no further directions are required to be issued in the matter “at this stage”.

(4) Disposed off accordingly.

(5) Needless to say that above observations be not construed on merits of the above three FIRs pending against the petitioner.
