1. Prayer in the present petition, filed under Section 483(3) of the BNSS, 2023, is for cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to respondent no.2 vide order dated 06.08.2025 (Annexure P-6) in case FIR No.0269 dated 10.09.2024, registered under Sections 420 & 120-B of the IPC, 1860, at Police Station Sector-65, District Gurugram.

2. In compliance of order dated 22.09.2025, respondent No.2- Muzammil Khan is present in Court. He has submitted that he had entered into the compromise dated 11.11.2024 with the petitioner before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. The full and final payment for settlement was of Rs.9 lacs was to be paid to the petitioner upto July 2025. He further submits that out of Rs.9 lacs, he has already paid Rs.3.25 lacs to the petitioner. He, however, submits that his mother is seriously ill and he is facing acute financial difficulty and he is not in a position to pay the remaining amount as per the terms and conditions of the compromise. He

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has requested that he would clear the remaining amount of Rs.5,75,000/- by July 2026. To show his *bona fide*, he has submitted that on 05.10.2025, he would transfer Rs.50,000/- in the account of the petitioner.

3. Keeping in view the attending circumstances of the respondent No.2, this Court allow him to clear the remaining amount of Rs.5,75,000/- by July 2026.

4. It is made clear that if he fails to comply with the terms and conditions of the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to approach this Court for recalling of order dated 06.08.2025 (Annexure P-6) passed by this Court.

5. Disposed off accordingly.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stands disposed off.
