



petitioner Sahibaaj Singh while recovery of heroin weighing 10 grams each was effected from Manpreet Singh @ Raja and Jatin @ Thela.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner does not suffer from any criminal antecedents. He further contends that no contraband was recovered from the petitioner-Sahibaaj Singh @ Vansh. He further contends that the investigation in the case in hand is at the initial stage and the contraband recovered from Manpreet Singh @ Raja is of intermediate quantity.

5. The aforesaid facts were not disputed by learned counsel for the State.

6. Keeping in view the nature of allegations levelled and the recovery effected and the fact that the investigation in the case in hand is at initial stage, I deem it appropriate to allow the present petitions. The petitioners are ordered to be admitted to regular bail subject to their furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

7. It is made clear that the petitioners shall not extend any threat and shall not influence any prosecution witness in any manner directly or indirectly.

8. The observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case and the trial Court shall decide the case on the basis of available material.
