Prayer in this petition, filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of direction in the nature of Habeas Corpus to official respondents for release of the detinue, namely Anjali, who is wife of the petitioner, from the illegal confinement/detention of respondent No. 4.

2. In compliance with the order dated 19.09.2025, the alleged detinue has been produced before this Court. She was referred to Counselling-cum-Mediation Room of this Court for her counselling, wherein she has stated that she is major and has performed marriage with the petitioner and wants to go with him. The parents of the alleged detinue are also present in person before this Court. They have stated that they have no objection if the detinue accompanies the petitioner. In view thereof, the present petition is disposed of. The detinue is at liberty to go with the petitioner as per her choice.
