1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of necessary and appropriate directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to bring on record the status report with regard to the complaint dated 03.09.2022 (Annexure P-1) filed by the petitioner with In-charge, Police Post Kitchlu Nagar, Police Station P.A.U., Ludhiana and for direction to respondent No.4 to not to harass the petitioner and his family members.

Learned State counsel, at the very outset, submits that nothing survives in the present petition as the grievance raised by the petitioner, in the present petition, has been substantially redressed and FIR No.39 dated 23.04.2025 has been registered on the complaint made by the petitioner under the relevant provisions of Indian Penal Code and Arms Act in

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the jurisdictional Police Station. Further, the recommendation has been sent to concerned quarters for cancellation of licence of weapon of Sham Sundar Gupta.

3. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further directions are required to be passed in the present petition and the same stands disposed of accordingly.
