1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.19, dated 27.01.2024, under Sections 21,25,29,61 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar (Rural) (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 07.11.2024 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
3. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
