1. The petitioners' (defendants) defence has been struck off for default in filing the written statement within the statutory period of 90 days.

The petitioners pray for one last opportunity to file the same.

2. The learned counsel representing the petitioners submits that the next date of hearing before the trial court for recording the plaintiffs' evidence, which is yet to be started, is 03.03.2025. She undertakes to file the written statement before the next date of hearing with copy in advance to the learned counsel representing the plaintiffs.

3. Per contra, the learned counsel representing the respondents submits that the petitioners entered appearance in the trial court on 11.01.2023, and failed to file their written statement after a period of nearly 1½ years.

4. This court has considered the submissions of the learned counsel representing the parties.

5. In view of the undertaking by the petitioners, they are granted one opportunity to file the written statement before the next date of hearing with copy in advance to the learned counsel representing the plaintiffss subject to payment of costs of Rs.5000/- which shall be condition precedent for filing the written statement.
6. With these observations, the revision petition is disposed of.
7. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
