The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 482 of BNSS, in case FIR No.127, dated 16.10.2024, under Sections 132, 221, 126(2), 324(4), 351(2) of BNS, 2023 and Section 4 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984, registered at Police Station Nehianwala, District Bathinda.
