The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR mentioned below:-

FIR No.	Dated	Police Station	Sections
221	26.09.2024	Jathlana, District Yamuna Nagar	115, 190, 191 (2), 333, 351(3), 352 of BNS

2. Vide order dated 12.11.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner was ordered to be released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation which is reproduced as under:-

“Petitioner-Deepak has filed petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 221 dated 26.09.2024, under Sections 115, 190, 191(2), 333, 351(3), 352 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, registered at Police Station Jathlana, District Yamuna Nagar (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for petitioner argued that all the allegations levelled against him are false. He also referred to



contents of FIR where it is observed that complainant was not molested or misbehaved as well as house was not vandalized. He further argued that the petitioner alongwith other villagers were standing outside the house in the street and has not taken part in the incident. Present petitioner states that co-accused Sagar had also received injuries in alleged incident. Copy of his MLR is also placed on record as Annexure P-4. Learned counsel further argues that co-accused Sumit Kalyan has also been granted ad interim anticipatory bail vide order dated 18.10.2024 (Annexure P-3) passed by this Court in CRM-M-51173-2024. Present petitioner is ready to join the investigation.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Rupinder Singh Jhand, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of State and prays for an adjournment to file status report. He may do so by the next date of hearing.

To be listed for hearing alongwith CRM-M-51173-2024 on 09.12.2024.

In the meantime, arrest of present petitioner is stayed till the next date of hearing, subject to his joining investigation.”

3. Learned State counsel has filed status report and further submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 20.11.2024. His further custodial interrogation is not required.
4. Keeping in view the above facts and circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 12.11.2024 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to compliance of usual terms and conditions requisite for grant of anticipatory bail.
