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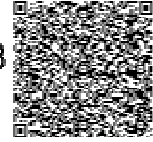
**SUBHAS MEHLA, J. (Oral)**

1. Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is facing serious and constant death threats from rival gang members lodged in the jail. These threats have created atmosphere of fear and danger to the life of petitioner and further submits that he may be transferred to some other convenient and secured jail within Punjab.

4. Mr. Subhash Godara, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepted notice on behalf of respondent-State and opposed the contentions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.



4. The petition is disposed of with a direction to move an appropriate application before appropriate authority in whose judicial custody the present petitioner is confined, for redressal of his grievance in accordance with law.
