1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of notice dated 30.09.2019 (Annexure P-6) whereby he was proposed to be compulsorily retired on attaining the age of 55 years.

2. The impugned notice was issued on 30.09.2019 and the petitioner was given three months notice. A period of five and a half years has passed away from the date of impugned notice. As per said notice, the petitioner was proposed to retire on attaining the age of 55 years. The maximum service tenure may be till 58 years. The petitioner, at present, is more than 58 years, thus, instant petition has rendered infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner was never served final order, thus, respondents may be directed to supply final order, if any.

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4. Faced with this, learned State counsel submits that petitioner would be supplied copy of order, if any, passed after issuance of impugned notice.

5. In the backdrop, the petition stands disposed of.
