1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.137, dated 05.07.2024, under Sections 420,406 of IPC, registered at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in compliance of the order dated 12.11.2024 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has already deposited an amount of Rs.50,000/- before the Trial Court/Illaqua Magistrate and has joined the investigation.
3. A status report by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Dasuya District Hoshiarpur has been filed on behalf of respondent-State and the same is taken on record.
4. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

5. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 12.11.2024 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S.
