This is claimant's appeal seeking enhancement of compensation of Rs.1,42,670/- granted vide award dated 10.10.2019 passed by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Jind (hereinafter referred to as, 'MACT').

2. A claim petition under Section 163-A of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (for short, 'MV Act') was filed by the appellant-claimant (Ashish) seeking compensation on account of injuries suffered by him in a motor vehicular accident which took place on 21.08.2017. Vide award dated 10.10.2019 (**ibid**), the claim petition was allowed and a sum of Rs.1,42,670/- along with interest @ 7.5% per annum from the date of filing of the petition till realization was awarded by the MACT.

3. Aggrieved thereby, and seeking enhancement of the compensation, the instant appeal has been preferred by the appellant.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that an amicable settlement has been arrived at between the parties and it has been agreed that



a sum of Rs.75,000/-, over and above the amount awarded by the MACT, shall be paid to the claimant by respondent No.2 (National Insurance Company Ltd.) within a period of four weeks from today.

5. Learned counsel for respondent No.2-Insurance Company submits that upon the requisite details being furnished, the said amount shall be transferred to the account of the claimant in accordance with law.

6. In view of the statements given by learned counsel for the parties, the present appeal is disposed of in terms thereof.

7. Pending application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
