This application has been filed for correction and incorporation of offence under Section 304 of BNS in the headnote as well as in the prayer clause of the main petition.

For the reasons mentioned in the application and keeping in view the submission made by counsel for the applicant, the application is allowed.

Main case

The instant petition under Section 482 of BNSS, has been

filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.148, dated 02.08.2024, under Sections 118(1), 115(2), 127(2), 191(3), 190, 351(2) (3) and 304 of BNS, registered at Police Station Guruharsahai, District Ferozepur.

This Court vide order dated 14.11.2024, while issuing notice of motion, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner, subject to his joining the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 14.11.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Mahesh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required further.

In view of the above, this Court deems it appropriate to consider that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required, hence, the order dated 14.11.2024 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
