The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to consider the petitioners' case under the Old Pension Scheme, as the same has already been granted to similarly situated candidates, vide orders dated 03.07.2024 and 08.07.2024, Annexures P-17 and P-18.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioners will be satisfied in case respondent no.2 is directed to decide the pending representation, dated 31.08.2025, Annexure P-19, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Amit Sahni, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State and submits that the pending representation, dated 31.08.2025, will be decided by respondent no.2/Director,



Elementary Education, by passing a speaking/reasoned order in accordance with law within a period of three months.

- 5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioners has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
- 6. Ordered accordingly.
- 7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioners.
